

EULA – End User License Agreement NoXi+J database.

This user agreement applies to the NoXi+J database, first provided on the 5th of March 2025. It has been released under specific conditions for sole purposes of scientific, non-commercial use. The data was recorded for the PANORAMA project. The database is stored and maintained by the Social Signal and Multimodal Interaction Lab at the Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (JAIST) and the Human-Centered AI Lab at Augsburg University. By signing this document, the user, he or she who will make use of the database or the database interface, agrees to the following terms. In this document, the term 'database' denotes both the actual data as well as the interface to the data.

1. Commercial use

The user may not use the database for any commercial purposes. Commercial purposes include, but are not limited to:

- proving the efficiency of commercial systems,
- testing commercial systems,
- using screenshots of subjects from the database in advertisements,
- selling data from the database.

2. Responsibility

The signee of this document must hold a permanent position at an academic or publicly funded research institute. Up to five other researchers affiliated with the same institute for whom the signee is responsible may be named at the end of this document, which will allow them to work with this dataset. All of the researchers need to sign this document.

3. Distribution

The user may not distribute the database in any way. Small portions (screenshots) may be distributed in publications as long as the publication complies with the terms stated in this EULA (article 5).

4. Access

The user may only use the database after this EULA has been signed and returned to the NoXi+J administrators. The user must create an account and return the signed EULA by sending this form to the email address shown in article 3.

Multiple users may sign one EULA in order to grant access to a group of researchers. Each researcher, however, must register with an individual username and password and upload a copy of the signed EULA.

The user may not grant anyone access to the database by giving out their username and password.

5. Publications

Publications include not only papers, but also presentations for conferences or educational purposes. The user may not use screenshots of subjects in publications. If you do post a screenshot, you will need to apply a mask or other processing to the face so that the individual cannot be identified.

All documents and papers that report on research that uses the NoXi+J Database will acknowledge this as follows: "(Portions of) the research in this paper use the NoXi+J Database collected for the PANORAMA project [x]", or similar language, where [x] is a reference to the following publication:

7. Changes

The PANORAMA and JAIST are allowed to change this EULA at any time; users will be informed about changes beforehand and given the choice to opt out of the new EULA. Opting out will render the previous EULA void.

8. Warranty

The database comes without any warranty, the Social Signal and Multimodal Interaction Lab at the Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology cannot be held accountable for any damage (physical, financial or otherwise) caused by the use of the database. No legal claims of any kind can be derived from accepting and using the Dataset. The Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology will take all reasonable action to prevent any damage by keeping the database virus free.
